

HUBUNGAN JENJANG KARIR PERAWAT DENGAN INSIDEN PADA PELAKSANAAN ENAM SASARAN KESELAMATAN PASIEN DI RAWAT INAP RSUD DEPOK

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Abstrak

Hasil penelitian terdahulu, di rumah sakit yang sama, menyebutkan bahwa angka insiden untuk Adverse event (KTD) mencapai 26.4% dan Near Miss (KNC) 38.4%, terkait implementasi sasaran keselamatan. Perawat dengan jenjang karir tertentu akan mempengaruhi penerapan sasaran keselamatan pasien dalam asuhan keperawatan. Penelitian ini bertujuan untuk mengetahui hubungan antara jenjang karir perawat dengan insiden pada pelaksanaan enam sasaran keselamatan pasien di Rawat Inap RSUD Depok. Penelitian ini merupakan penelitian kuantitatif dengan metode cross sectional dengan populasi perawat di ruang rawat inap RSUD Depok. Teknik sampling yang digunakan adalah acidental sampling dengan jumlah sampel sebanyak 48 responden. Analisis data menggunakan Uji Chi Square menghasilkan bahwa insiden pada pelaksanaan enam sasaran keselamatan pasien sebesar 65,4% dilakukan oleh perawat junior, nilai p-value = 0,003 yang artinya terdapat hubungan antara jenjang karir dengan insiden pada pelaksanaan enam sasaran keselamatan pasien. Peneliti menyarankan agar pihak rumah sakit dapat mengembangkan kompetensi perawat melalui pengembangan jenjang karir agar penerapan sasaran keselamatan pasien dapat diterapkan 100%.

THE RELATIONSHIP OF NURSE CAREER LEVEL WITH INCIDENTS IN ON THE IMPLEMENTATION OF SIX PATIENT SAFETY OBJECTIVES IN THE INPATIENT ROOM OF RSUD DEPOK

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Abstract

The results of previous studies, at the same hospital, stated that the incidence rate for Adverse events (KTD) reached 26.4% and Near Miss (KNC) 38.4%, related to the implementation of safety goals. Nurses with certain career paths will affect the implementation of patient safety goals in nursing care. This study aims to determine the relationship between nurse career paths and the incidence of the implementation of six patient safety goals in the Depok Hospital Inpatient. This study is a quantitative study with a cross sectional method with a population of nurses in the inpatient room at RSUD Depok. The sampling technique used is accidental sampling with a total sample of 48 respondents. Data analysis using the Chi Square test resulted that 65.4% of incidents in the implementation of the six patient safety goals were carried out by junior nurses, the p-value = 0.003 which means that there is a relationship between career paths and incidents in the implementation of the six patient safety goals. Researchers suggest that the hospital can provide training related to patient safety at all levels of nurse careers so that the application of patient safety goals can be applied 100%.
