

PELAKSANAAN SANKSI KEBIRI KIMIA KEPADA TERPIDANA KEJAHATAN SEKSUAL ANAK DI INDONESIA OLEH DOKTER

ABSTRAK

Peningkatan signifikan jumlah kasus kejahatan seksual terhadap anak dalam beberapa dekade terakhir telah mendorong berbagai negara di dunia untuk menegakkan aturan hukum yang tepat berupa kebiri kimia. Hukuman kebiri kimia sebagai sanksi tambahan telah diterapkan di Indonesia. Peraturan pemerintah yang menerapkan sanksi kebiri kimia telah menunjuk dokter untuk melaksanakan sanksi tersebut kepada terpidana. Hal tersebut menimbulkan kontroversi dalam pelaksanaannya yang tidak sesuai dengan Undang-Undang Praktik Kedokteran Indonesia dan Kode Etik Kedokteran Indonesia. Berdasarkan hal tersebut perlu dilakukan penelitian hukum. Penelitian hukum yang dilakukan adalah penelitian normatif. Data yang digunakan adalah data sekunder. Analisis utama dilakukan melalui pendekatan komparatif terhadap peraturan perundang-undang di berbagai negara. Peneliti membandingkan hukum kebiri kimia di tiga negara untuk memberikan rekomendasi pembentukan peraturan hukum yang kolaboratif, adaptif, reformatif, dan efektif untuk penunjukan dokter pelaksana kebiri kimia di Indonesia.

ABSTRACT

The significant increase in the number of cases of sexual crimes against children in the last few decades has encouraged various countries in the world to enforce the proper rule of law. The chemical castration penalty as an additional sanction has been applied in Indonesia. Government regulations of implementing chemical castration sanction have appointed doctors to carry out this sanction on the convicts. It has created controversy in its implementation that is not in accordance with the Indonesian Medical Practice Law and the Indonesian Medical Code of Ethics. This research is a normative study. It used secondary data. The main analysis is carried out through a comparative approach to the laws and regulations of various countries. The researcher compared the laws of chemical castration in three countries to provide recommendations for establishing legal regulations that are collaborative, adaptive, reformative, and effective (C,A,R,E) for the appointment of doctors implementing chemical castration.
