Abstrak

Skripsi ini membahas tentang ASEAN Coordinating Centre for Humanitarian Assistance on Disaster Management (AHA Centre) dalam penanggulangan bencana Topan Haiyan di Filipina tahun 2013-2014. Filipina merupakan salah satu negara yang memiliki kerentanan yang tinggi akan bencana khususnya bencana topan di kawasan Asia Tenggara. Hampir setiap tahun negara ini ditimpa bencana topan mulai dari skala kecil hingga skala besar. AHA Centre sebagai pusat bantuan kemanusiaan di Asia Tenggara memiliki tujuan untuk memfasilitasi kerjasama dan koordinasi diantara negara anggota dengan PBB dan organisasi internasional untuk penanganan bencana dan tanggap darurat bencana. Bagaimana peran AHA Centre dalam penanggulangan bencana Topan Haiyan di Filipina menjadi permasalahan penelitian ini. Penulis menggunakan kerangka pemikiran Regionalisme, Human Security, dan Mitigasi Bencana serta menggunakan metode kualitatif, dengan jenis penelitian deskriptif dalam penelitian ini. AHA Centre memiliki mekanisme dan perangkat operasional dalam bantuan bencana dan tanggap darurat yang diharapkan mampu mengurangi dampak yang ditimbulkan akibat bencana. Upaya yang telah dilakukan AHA Centre dibagi menjadi tiga tahap: sebelum, saat, dan setelah bencana dengan berbagai hambatan yang membuat pelaksanaan operasi bencana kurang optimal.

Abstract

This thesis discusses the ASEAN Coordinating Centre for Humanitarian Assistance on Disaster Management (AHA Centre) in the response to Typhoon Haiyan in the Philippines for 2013-2014. The Philippines is one of the countries that has a high vulnerability of disaster, especially Typhoon in the Southeast Asian region. Almost every year the country is hit by typhoon from small to large scale. AHA Centre as a center for humanitarian assistance in Southeast Asia has the aim to facilitate cooperation and coordination among ASEAN member states and the United Nations and international organizations for disaster management and emergency response. How AHA Centre's role in disaster management in the Philippines Typhoon Haiyan was named a problem of this research. The author uses the framework of thinking Regionalism, Human Security, and Disaster Mitigation by using qualitative methods, with a descriptive research in this study. AHA Centre has mechanisms and operational tools in disaster relief and emergency response that is to reduce the impact caused by the disaster. The efforts have been made by AHA Centre is divided into three stages: before, during and after a disaster with a variety of obstacles that make the implementation of disaster operations less than the optimum.
