ABSTRAK

Penelitian ini membahas mengenai kerjasama pemerintah Indonesia dengan *International Fund and Agriculture Development* (IFAD) melalui program *Coastal Community Development Project* (CCDP) di Parepare Sulawesi Tengah periode 2012-2015. Indonesia merupakan negara kepulauan yang memiliki dua pertiga luas lautan lebih besar dan potensi dalam sumber daya laut sangat besar dimana seharusnya masyarakat pesisir memiliki taraf kesejahteraan yang cukup. Akan tetapi keadaan masyarakat pesisir sebagian besar masih hidup di bawah garis kemiskinan. Dengan itu pemerintah membuat program PEMP (Pemberdayaan Ekonomi Masyarakat Pesisir) namun program PEMP gagal dan akhirnya pemerintah membentuk kerjasama dengan IFAD untuk meningkatkan pembangunan ekonomi masyarakat pesisir. Sehingga penelitian ini mengangkat pertanyaan mengenai “*Bagaimana kerjasama pemerintah Indonesia dengan International Fund and Agriculture Development (IFAD) melalui program Coastel Community Development Project (CCDP) di Parepare Sulawesi Selatan Tengah periode 2012-2013?*”. Untuk menjawab pertanyaan tersebut peneliti menggunakan teori dan konsep. Yang terkait satu sama lain yakni teori kerjasama internasional, bantuan luar negeri dan konsep CCDP, yang mana kerjasama yang dilakukan membuat program pemberdayaan masyarakat pesisir, bantuan dalam bentuk barang dan bantuan teknis. Metode penelitian menggunakan metode kualitatif deskriptif yang menekankan penggalian informasi dan data kerjasama pemerintah Indonesia dengan IFAD melalui program CCDP. Hasil dari penelitian ini menjelaskan bentuk kerjasama yang dilakukan pemerintah Indonesia yaitu kementerian kelautan dan perikanan dengan IFAD dapat meningkatkan taraf kesejahteraan masyarakat pesisir Parepare Sulawesi Selatan.

ABSTRACT

This research discusses the cooperation of Indonesian government with International Fund and Agriculture Development (IFAD) through Coastal Community Development Project (CCDP) program in Parepare Central Sulawesi period 2012-2015. Indonesia is an archipelagic country that has two-thirds of the larger ocean area and potential in marine resources is huge where the coastal community should have sufficient welfare. However, most coastal communities are still living below the poverty line. With that the government created the PEMP (Community Economic Empowerment) program but the PEMP program failed and eventually the government formed a partnership with IFAD to improve the economic development of coastal communities. So this research raises the question of "How is the cooperation of Indonesian government with International Fund and Agriculture Development (IFAD) through Coastel Community Development Project (CCDP) program in Parepare Central Sulawesi period 2012-2013?". To answer the question the researcher uses theory and concepts. The related one another is the theory of international cooperation, foreign aid and the concept of CCDP, which the cooperation undertaken to make the coastal community empowerment program, assistance in the form of goods and technical assistance. The research method used a descriptive qualitative method that emphasizes the digging of information and data of Indonesian government cooperation with IFAD through CCDP program. The results of this study explain the form of cooperation undertaken by the government of Indonesia namely the ministry of marine and fisheries with IFAD in improving the welfare of coastal communities Parepare South Sulawesi.
