

**PENGARUH PEMBERIAN EDUKASI PERAWAT TERKAIT
DENGAN *MORSE FALL SCALE* TERHADAP KEPATUHAN
PERAWAT DALAM MELAKUKAN PENCEGAHAN RISIKO
JATUH DI RUANG MAHONI I RUMAH SAKIT
BHAYANGKARA TK I RADEN SAID SUKANTO**

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Abstrak

Salah satu cara rumah sakit mendukung keselamatan pasien adalah dengan meminta perawat melakukan penilaian risiko jatuh. Penerapan pemberian edukasi pada perawat terkait dengan Morse Fall Scale bertujuan untuk membuktikan kepatuhan perawat dalam melakukan pencegahan resiko jatuh di Ruang Mahoni I Rumah Sakit Bhayangkara TK I Raden Said Sukanto. Pemberian edukasi Morse Fall Scale ini diberikan pada 5 perawat yang bertugas dengan shift yang berbeda. Evaluasi kepatuhan perawat dalam melakukan pencegahan risiko jatuh diukur menggunakan kuesioner kepatuhan perawat dalam pencegahan risiko jatuh. Hasil evaluasi menunjukkan bahwa sebanyak 3 perawat (60%) telah patuh dalam melakukan pencegahan risiko jatuh, sedangkan 2 perawat (40%) lainnya menunjukkan belum patuh dalam melakukan pencegahan risiko jatuh. Hasil tersebut menunjukkan bahwa pemberian edukasi morse fall scale pada perawat berperan penting dalam pelaksanaan pencegahan risiko jatuh di ruangan. Perawat diharapkan dapat menerapkan pencegahan risiko jatuh di ruangan baik menggunakan morse fall scale maupun metode assessment yang lain.

**THE EFFECT OF NURSE EDUCATION RELATED TO
MORSE FALL SCALE ON NURSE COMPLIANCE IN
PREVENTING THE RISK OF FALLING IN MAHONY ROOM

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Abstract

One way hospitals support patient safety is by asking nurses to conduct a fall risk assessment. The application of providing education to nurses related to the Morse Fall Scale aims to prove the compliance of nurses in preventing the risk of falling in Mahogany Room I Bhayangkara Hospital TK I Raden Said Sukanto. This Morse Fall Scale education was given to 5 nurses on different shifts. Evaluation of nurse compliance in preventing fall risk was measured using a nurse compliance questionnaire in preventing fall risk. The results of the evaluation showed that as many as 3 nurses (60%) were obedient in preventing the risk of falling, while the other 2 nurses (40%) showed that they were not obedient in preventing the risk of falling. These results indicate that the provision of Morse fall scale education to nurses plays an important role in the implementation of fall risk prevention in the room. Nurses are expected to be able to apply fall risk prevention in the room using either the Morse fall scale or other assessment methods
